Shelton State Community College 2025-2026 Institutional Scholarships

Shelton State Community College offers competitive scholarships to qualified students who are **residents of the state of Alabama.** Scholarships are awarded based on availability of awards. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee a scholarship award. Scholarship applications must be completed online via Award Spring. Check the scholarships webpage for details. **The scholarship application deadline is March 1, 2025, by 11:59 p.m.** Alabama Community College System policy states that any student who is awarded institutional scholarship hours is limited to a total of eighty-two award hours. Scholarships may not exceed 57 semester credit hours per academic year (Fall, Spring, Summer). Scholarships will not apply towards courses not in current program of study and towards tuition only; **students will be responsible for all fees.**

Alabama Community College System policy requires that scholarship recipients be U.S. citizens or resident aliens who meet institutional requirements. Every applicant is required to submit an application for admission to the College and an application for federal financial aid. Students should apply for the academic year(s) in which the award will be provided. Students must apply for federal financial aid online at www.studentaid.gov. Shelton State's school code is 005691.

Academic Scholarships

Academic scholarships are awarded for one year. Students will be eligible for the renewal of their scholarship for the second year based on scholarship requirements being met. Students will not be eligible to receive an academic scholarship for more than two consecutive years.

Other Institutional Scholarships

AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIPS	 First-time, new, or current SSCC students are eligible. The cumulative or unweighted GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.50 after fall 2024 grades or the GED equivalent. The award is based on leadership potential, community service, and commitment to Shelton State. Candidates are ranked based on the qualities listed above, academic performance, and an interview held on the Martin Campus. Interviews will be held March 24-27, 2025. Candidates will be contacted via (<u>A#@alabama.edu)</u> email to schedule interviews. Recipients must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 each term and be enrolled as full-time students to remain on scholarship. The award waives tuition for only up to sixteen hours in the fall and spring and up to twelve hours in the summer for the 2025-2026 academic year. <u>The student will be responsible for all fees. The scholarship will not cover courses that are not in your correct program of study</u>. Students must reapply each year.
COLLEGIATE 100® SCHOLARSHIPS	 First-time, new, or current SSCC students are eligible. The institutional or unweighted GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.00 after fall 2024 grades or the GED equivalent. The award is based on articulation, leadership potential, community service, and commitment to Shelton State and the Collegiate 100[®]. Interviews will be held in April 2025. Candidates will be contacted via (<u>A#@alabama.edu</u>) email to schedule interviews. Recipients must maintain an institutional GPA of 2.00 each term and maintain enrollment at a minimum of 9 hours to remain on scholarship. The award waives tuition for only for sixteen hours in the fall and spring and up to twelve hours in the summer for the 2025-2026 academic year. <u>The student will be responsible for all fees. The scholarship will not cover courses that are not in your correct program of study</u>. Students must reapply each year.

FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS	 First time, new, or current SSCC students are eligible. The institutional or unweighted GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.50 after fall 2024 grades or be the GED equivalent. The award is available in dance, music, theatre, and visual arts. Candidates must attend Fine Arts Audition Day on Thursday, March 6, 2025 and Friday, March 21, 2025. Candidates will be contacted via email (<u>A#@alabama.edu</u>) regarding auditions. Candidates must enroll in a minimum of twelve hours and be actively engaged as artists. Recipients must maintain an institutional GPA of 2.5 each term and be enrolled as full-time students to remain on scholarship. Awards are based on the number of credit hours awarded. Hours are awarded for both fall 2025 and spring 2026 terms with one-half of the award available for each term. The award waives tuition only. <u>The student will be responsible for all fees. The scholarship will not cover courses that are not in your correct program of study.</u> Students will be eligible for the renewal of their scholarship for a second year based on scholarship requirements being met.
R.E.A.C.H SCHOLARSHIPS	 R.E.A.C.H. stands for Resources in Education Achieving Change and Hope. First-time, new, or current SSCC students are eligible. The institutional or unweighted GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.50 after fall 2024 grades or the GED equivalent. The award is based on academic performance. Recipients must maintain a 2.50 institutional GPA each term to remain on scholarship. The award is valued at \$3,000 (\$1,500 per semester). The award waives tuition only for twelve hours for fall 2025 and twelve hours for spring 2026 (no summer award). <u>The student will be responsible for all fees. The scholarship will not cover courses that are not in your correct program of study.</u> Students must reapply each year.

TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIPS• Recipients must maintain an institutional GPA of 2.0 each term to remain on scholarship. • Recipients must enroll in courses required by the technical program of study. • Hours awarded may be used in fall 2025, spring 2026, and/or summer 2026. • Awards are based on the total number of credit hours awarded. The award waives tuition only. The student will be responsible for all fees. The scholarship will not cover courses that are not in your correct program of study. • Students must reapply each year.
